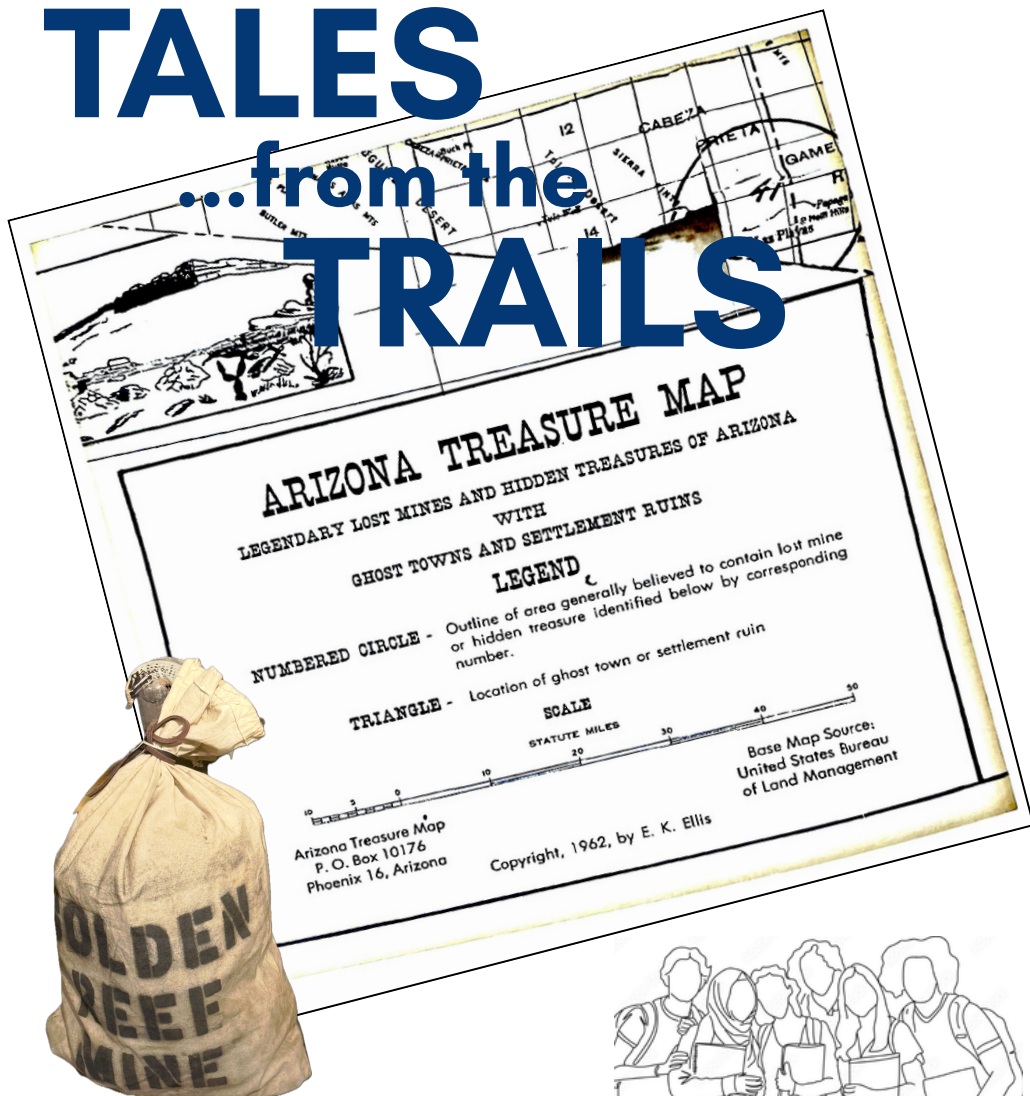

What did blacksmiths make?

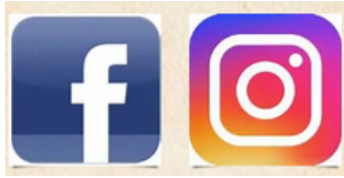

Stamp Mill

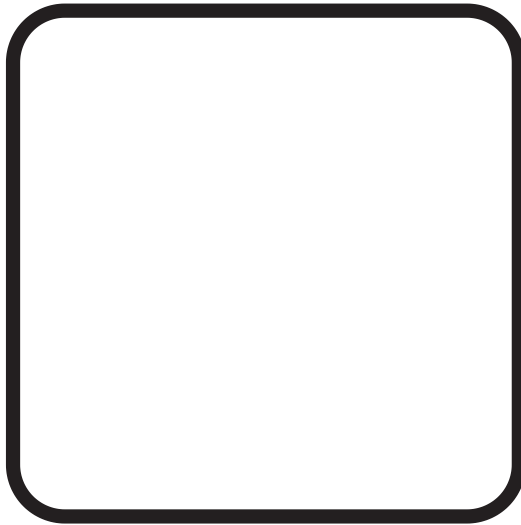
